

Bradley-Buchanan Woods & Pond Lot

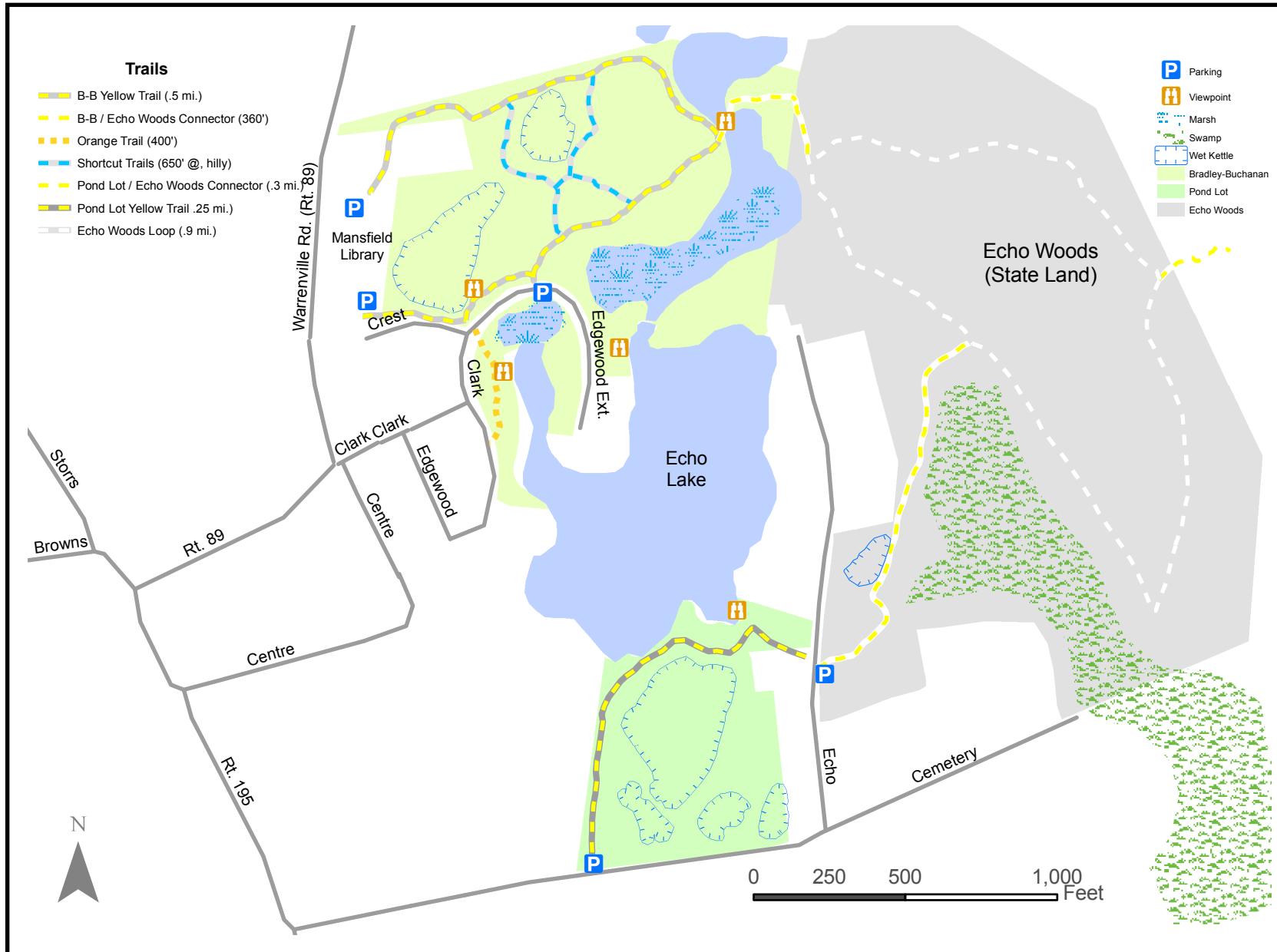

Bradley-Buchanan Preserve is a 22-acre parcel bought by the Trust in 1970. Pond Lot is a 10-acre parcel donated by Hugh and Betsey Hamill in 1986. Both lie in a glacial landscape known as a pitted kame terrace, characterized by sandy outwash soils pockmarked by depressions known as kettles. The kettles were created by large chunks of glacial ice that were buried and later melted. While some of the kettles are dry, many contain water and provide a variety of aquatic habitats.
