



This preserve offers four distinct habitats for wildlife. In addition to the young oak-hickory forest that covers much of it, there are also two agricultural fields – one corn and hay. A small marsh lies in the northeast corner and is surrounded by shrubby vegetation that provides good wildlife cover.

The loop trail that takes you through forest, streams, the hay field and historic foundations.

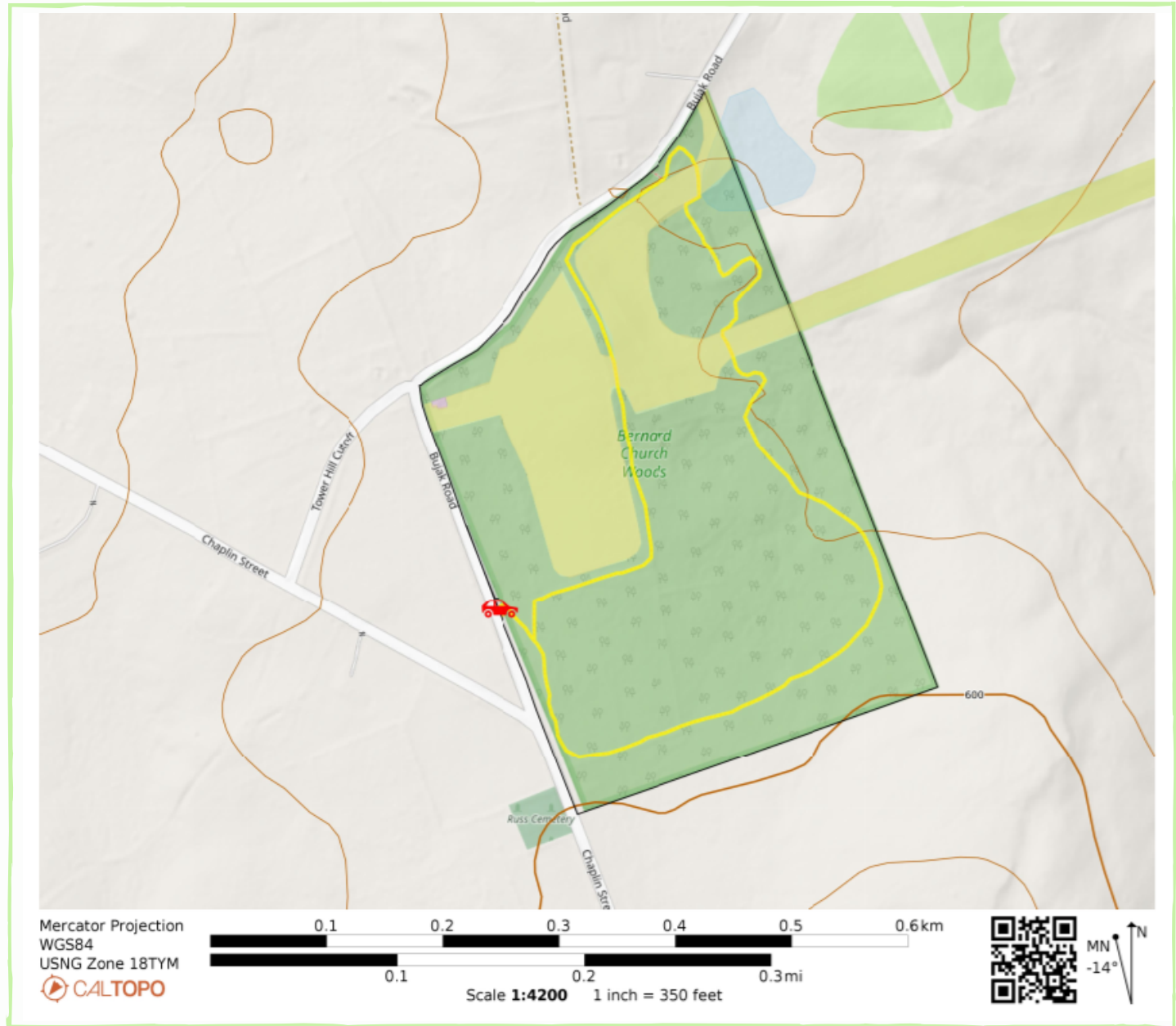
